Severn Trent closed the A6097 overnight in contravention of the local guidelines causing unnecessary delays and nuisance.

5. Derelict House

RJ has asked the NSDC to compulsory purchase the derelict bungalow sited on the corner of David's Lane and Pasture View as the building is now envisaged as a danger.

6. Slip Road Railings

RJ to follow up remedial work previously requested to repair damaged metal railings at bottom of slip road

7. Traffic Nuisance

YG to write formally again to the MJ Tour Bus Company, requesting reduction of nuisance caused to householders on both Main Street and David's Lane, created by the reversing of vehicles and the ~~*~~ picking up and dropping off of passengers.

8. Christmas Lights

JyS to investigate the costs and availability of a prefabricated Christmas tree, to be installed on GPC land adjacent the slip road for the Christmas period. Report ready for next GPC meeting.
