No reply received from Eddie Brennan at NCC following letter sent regarding Common land and its uses, the Clerk and Cllr Jackson to chase for reply.

The Clerk reported back on her telephone meeting with NSDC Alan Batty regarding options for the riverside and anti social behavior. Alan Batty is happy to attend a virtual meeting with Councillors. The Clerk to arrange this to include Cllr Jackson, ASAP

Councillor Jackson confirmed that a PSPO was not straight forward to get nor was the policing of the act easily managed.
