20.01.05 NSDC, Highways and Other County Matters, – Cllr Jackson
NSDC are hoping to get the tips opened and are extremely concerned about the increased fly tipping in the whole county. Waste bins and recycling bins are being emptied, parks and verges are being cut. Highways will be doing more road repairs from next week. Cllr Jackson has reported the issues on the A6097 opposite the caravans. Huge £50m bill for Social Care has to be met by NCC. Garden waste collection to be restarted from June 1st. NSDC
Concerns were expressed about cars parking by the bend on Main Street by the stables causing traffic issues. There were reports of motor bikes on the bridle way again.
